REQUIRED INFORMATION

- **Verification of Income:** Include a copy of the front page of last year's Federal Tax Return. Please black out personal information such as social security numbers.
- **Verification of Grades:** Include a copy of last year's school transcript. You will also be responsible for submitting first semester grades once they are posted.
- **Verification of Work/Volunteering:** Include proof of player work (bantam, High School) or volunteer experience within the past year. If there is no work/volunteer experience, please explain why. Include whether or not there is parental participation in the STAHA organization and if you would be willing to participate as volunteer needs present themselves. (STAHA is an all-volunteer organization and at various times through the season, we will need volunteers. We often partner with the rink to help staff their events as well as our own).
- **Attach an explanation of why you, the player, wants to play hockey.**

- If your income verification does not reflect need based on your income, please provide an explanation of the compelling event or situation that necessitates the request for a scholarship. Please indicate how much scholarship money you are requesting, and if we are unable to provide the amount you request, would a portion of that money still be accepted.

All Scholarship Applications must include all of the REQUIRED INFORMATION outlined above. Failure to include any of these items will result in disqualification of the applicant for consideration.

Weight is given to those applicants showing a compelling current event that resulted in the need for consideration.

The participation of the player in working/volunteering in order to earn money for their hockey fees is an important consideration. However, the Scholarship Committee understands this isn't always possible for a variety of reasons (age, school, etc), so we allow for an explanation if there is no work/volunteer experience.

The Scholarship Committee believes all applicants should be given equal consideration. Therefore, applications will be reviewed as submitted. Requests for additional information will only be made in rare cases.

Finally, we only have a finite amount of funds to distribute each year. Sometimes, the expressed need can outweigh the amount of funds available. We do our best to provide assistance to those who truly need it.
